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Electrolysis Hair Removal

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What hair can be treated with Electrolysis?

Coarse dark and white hair around the lip, jaw and chin affect many women from their 40's onwards due to hormonal changes and menopause. These hairs are also unwanted side-effects if you suffer from Poly Cystic Ovaries, Endometriosis, Fibromyalgia, and other hormone-related conditions.

How does Electrolysis work?

A tiny flexible fine probe (about the size of an eyelash) is inserted into the hair follicle and then a tiny burst of heat and energy is targeted at the root of the hair. This prevents nutrients feeding the hair so it will become weaker, finer, and will eventually die. After repeated treatments the hair is no longer able to grow and complete hair free results are obtained.

Electrolysis is the only proven permanent method of hair removal and is a safe and effective treatment.

Is Electrolysis Safe?

Electrolysis was first invented in 1875 and is a proven and treatment. It is safe when performed correctly by a qualified therapist. Modern technology has meant electrolysis has become gentler, more comfortable and more effective, so if you haven't tried electrolysis for many years give it another go – it's changed!

What areas can be treated?

Anywhere on the body, but it is usually used for facial areas, like the brow, lip and chin.

How many treatments will I need?

Each hair will require repeated treatments because each hair has its own growing cycle and blood supply and each treatment will gradually weaken the hair until eventually it will be destroyed. Therefore permanent results can take many sessions and the number required depends on many factors including your age, type of hair, when they grow (cyclical/hormone driven), any medical conditions you may have and if you are on medication.



Why do I need a Consultation and Patch Test and what happens in it?

It's to make sure that the treatment is right for you and your hair concerns, and also to make sure it will be safe for you. Even if you have had electrolysis before at another salon you still will still need this to book this first, before we can treat you.

We will go through a detailed consultation to ensure if treatment is suitable for you. It also gives you a chance to ask questions about the treatment. We will then treat several hairs in the area/areas you want treated, to determine the best settings from the machine to achieve the best results for you. 24 hours later, if you have no adverse reactions, we will then book you an appointment for your first full treatment.

What about hygiene?

We sterilise the area of skin to be treated and the therapist wears gloves for the entire treatment. For each client a brand new sterile probe/s is used and then all are disposed of after the treatment - we NEVER re-use the probes.

What equipment do you use?

We use a Sterex Blend Electrolysis machine. Sterex are the leaders in Electrolysis equipment, and is a British company established in 1982. They support us with additional training and advice when we need it.

What qualifications do you have ?

All therapists have undergone extensive training and are fully qualified and insured to carry out the treatment. In addition, Tranquil Beauty Clinic is registered with Basingstoke Borough Council Environmental Health department who have approved and granted us with a license to offer Electrolysis which confirms our competency and qualifications as therapists, and our premises are approved for health and hygiene. Our certificates are on the website.



Before your Electrolysis treatment

48 hours before or after your Electrolysis Patch test or full treatments:

- Do not exfoliate or shave
- Do not wax or bleach the area
- Do not use a sunbed. Do not suntan / be in the sun
- Do not swim in salt or chlorine water
- Do not use any product on the area/s to be treated that contain AHA's, Glycolic/Lactic/Salicylic acid
- Do not use oil-based products on the area/s to be treated

After your Electrolysis treatment

After each of your electrolysis treatments it is important that you follow the aftercare advice. This will help prevent further irritation to the area treated, allowing it to calm quickly and prevent infection.

- Avoid touching the treated area
- Do not apply make-up over treated area for 24 hours
- Avoid tight fitting clothes on the treated area
- Do not use sunbeds
- If you can't avoid the sun, use a high factor sunscreen
- Avoid heat treatments e.g. sauna, jacuzzi
- Avoid swimming
- Avoid wearing perfume and chemical-based products over treated area
- Use recommended after-care products
- Avoid waxing, plucking or bleaching the hair in between treatments, the hair may be cut only
- Avoid false tan products
