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# Electrolysis for Skin Marks and Tags

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## What are the types of skin marks you can treat with Electrolysis?

### Skin tags

Soft limp raised tissue with normal or pigmented tone. Usually caused by friction e.g. neck, underarm, under bust

### Milia

Small hard bumps the size of a pinhead, whiteish or yellowish, they contain sebum and skin debris. Usually found on eyelids, under eyes and on cheeks

### Cherry angiomas

Small bright red dot, sometimes raised, and often found on the chest and abdomen

### Mature angioma / Campbell Spot

Permanent dilation of capillaries forming a raised bloody coloured lump

### Thread veins

Very fine veins often visible on nose and cheeks and can be red, blue or purple in colour

### Spider veins

Small red dot with very fine thread veins radiating from the centre

## How does Electrolysis work?

A tiny sterile needle is inserted into the skin and a burst of heat is applied. This will quaterise any blood supply. It can also cut away any tag or growth.

## What areas can be treated?

Anywhere on the face and body.

## How many treatments will I need?

Usually just one treatment will remove each mark.



## What happens in my appointment?

We will go through a detailed consultation and look at the marks you are concerned about, under a magnifying lamp. We can then advise if they can be treated. The area/areas are then treated, and you will be given aftercare advice, and a small pot of Aloe Vera gel, to aid healing

## How will my skin be afterwards?

You may experience some tenderness immediately after. There will be some protective healing crusts formed and they can last up to 5 days—this is normal and shows the skin is healing. At this time your skin may look worse than before, therefore you should avoid having the treatment directly before any work or social activities.

## What about hygiene?

We sterilise the area of skin to be treated and the therapist wears gloves for the entire treatment. For each client a brand new sterile needle is used and then all are disposed of after the treatment - we NEVER re-use the probes.

## What equipment do you use?

We use a Sterex Electrolysis machine. Sterex are the leaders in Electrolysis equipment, and is a British company established in 1982. They support us with additional training and advice when we need it.

## What qualifications do you have ?

All therapists have undergone extensive training and are fully qualified and insured to carry out the treatment. In addition, Tranquil Beauty Clinic is registered with Basingstoke Borough Council Environmental Health department who have approved and granted us with a license to offer Electrolysis which confirms our competency and qualifications as therapists, and our premises are approved for health and hygiene. Our certificates are on the website.



## Before your treatment

### 48 hours before treatment:

- Do not exfoliate or shave in the areas
- Do not use a sunbed. Do not suntan / be in the sun
- Do not swim in salt or chlorine water
- Do not use any product on the area/s to be treated that contain AHA's, Glycolic/Lactic/Salicylic acid
- Do not use oil-based products on the area/s to be treated

## After your treatment

### For the first 48 hours

- Do not touch the treated areas
- Do not wash or cleanse the treated areas
- Avoid alcohol and spicy foods if you have a tendency to flush
- No exercise, or anything that will cause sweating and dilation of capillaries e.g. sunbeds, saunas or jacuzzi
- No make-up over on the treated areas
- Avoid tight fitting clothes on the treated areas
- Avoid the sun and false tan products
- Avoid swimming
- Avoid wearing perfume and chemical-based products over treated area
- Use Aloe Vera Gel provided

### After 48 hours

- Protective healing crust will have formed, sealing the skin and preventing infection
- After these crusts have appeared you can gently cleanse the area
- The skin should be kept as dry as possible until the crusts naturally drop off
- Continue to use Aloe Vera gel
- Use a minimum of SPF 30 sunscreen
